How to: Change your password
☐ Profile > Settings and privacy > Manage Account > Password: Choose a strong and
unique password combining letters, numbers, and symbols.
? Why It Matters: A strong, unique password helps protect your account from being easily
hacked or compromised, especially if other accounts you own are breached.
How to: Ensure 2FA is enabled:
☐ Profile > Settings and privacy > Security > 2-Step Verification: Enable 2FA and choose
an authentication method, such as SMS, email, or an authenticator app.
Complete Setup: Follow the prompts to verify your identity and secure your account.
? Why It Matters: 2FA adds an additional layer of security by requiring a second form of
verification, making it significantly harder for unauthorized users to access your account.

Be Cautious with Links and Messages • How to: Avoid Clicking Suspicious Links: Be wary of links in messages or comments, even from people you know. Report and Block: If you receive unsolicited or suspicious content, report and block the user. ? Why It Matters: Phishing attempts and malicious links are common on social media platforms. Being cautious helps protect your account from potential threats. Prepare for Account Recovery O How to: Settings > Account > Manage Account: Ensure your email and phone number are up-todate. ? Why It Matters: Keeping your recovery options current ensures you can quickly regain

access to your account if it's ever compromised.
